Three cheers for Olga!!! We need more members as devoted as she is! She fills in at our store when ever called...we appreciate you Olga, and "thank you".

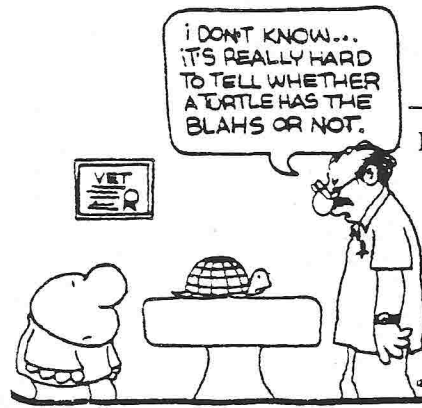

# Close to Home

**EARTHQUAKE PREDICTOR** Jim Berkland says "lost pet" ads and tidal tables tell him Southern California should expect moderate quake this month. Berkland is a geologist for Santa Clara County, which early last year ordered him to stop issuing earthquake predictions while on the job. He also has a private service, with an office in Menlo Park, that issues an earthquake newsletter. Berkland projects a 50 percent chance of a quake of magnitude 5.0 or larger by next Tuesday, and said he is 80 percent confident that such a quake will strike within 140 miles of Los Angeles by Jan. 31. Most seismologists say Berkland's predictions have no scientific merit.

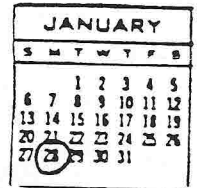
